


# Read On Summer Tutoring Program



## What is the Read On program?

Read On is a tutoring program that helps children improve their reading, math and French skills. Each child is paired with a Read On Literacy Tutor and receives 45 minutes of tutoring daily over the course of a two-week session.

We run multiple sessions throughout the summer. Our tutors are university students who have a special interest in literacy. This program is offered at both the Main Library and St. Paul Avenue Branch.

The Read On program celebrates over 30 years of helping children in Brantford practice and build on their reading, math and language skills!

## Is my child eligible?

Children entering grades 2 to 6 in September 2019 are eligible for this program.

All tutors have had considerable experience in working directly with children and receive intensive training before the program begins. Please note, however, this program is not designed (nor are the tutors qualified) to teach children who have been classified with special needs.

## How do I register my child?

Registration begins online starting Saturday, June 1, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. In person and phone calls will not be accepted.

**Please note:** You may only register your child for **one session** at this time. If your child is registered for more than one session, all but one time slot will be removed without notice. If you are interested in a second session, then please let your child's tutor know and your child will be added to a wait list.

If you are registering more than one child, you must register them individually. You cannot register all of your children at the same time.
