

GRADUATION PLANNING

Dear Parents

As the end of the year is fast approaching, our planning for Graduation must be under way. Grad night is Monday, June 25 at 7:00 pm. in our gym.

Tickets for the Graduation ceremony will be sent home with each student. Each family will be receiving the same number of tickets to be fair. Tickets are being issued because of the space available in our gym and to enable the Parent Council to better plan and prepare the refreshments. If additional tickets are needed for family members, please contact the office to make a request. Only those with official tickets will be admitted to the gym. "Sunday Best" dress code is requested for the guests. This is a very special and formal occasion for our Grads and the school community, so formal dress by the guests is expected.

Students must be here by 6:15 for a formal Graduation group picture. Parents will be asked to go directly to the gym to view the students' displays and an informal slide show. Once all of the students are in place for the picture, we will announce for the parents to come to the photo area and take as many group pictures as you wish.

Following the Graduation exercises, we will have some light refreshments in the gym organized and served by the Parent Council and other school Parents. A photo area will be set up so families can take pictures more easily.

Graduation Mass

The Graduation experience here at St Basil Catholic School involves many activities. All the Graduating students of St. Basil parish will be attending a Grad Mass at the church on Friday, June 22. We will bus the students. There is no cost to the students but all students are required to be dressed in at least their Sunday best. Many Students wear the outfits they wore on Graduation night. The permission form is attached. It needs to be returned to the school as soon as possible.

Parents are welcome to attend the Mass.

Graduation Luncheon and Dance

The Grads are also invited to a Grad Dance on the afternoon of Friday, June 22. This will be held at St. Basil's Parish Hall, which is attached to the church. All Assumption College feeder school Grads will also be attending. What a great way to begin to make friends for Grade 9. It will be fully supervised by Grade 8 teachers from the schools.

Since we are going to be at St. Basil's already, the school will provide a pizza lunch for the students between the Mass and the start of the Dance at no cost to the students.

To make this event a more special occasion, the students are required to be dressed in their "Sunday Best" attire. Students are welcome to wear their Graduation dresses or suits. This will match the atmosphere of the dance

The permission form to attend the dance is also attached to be returned as soon as possible.

Graduation Breakfast

A St. Basil Graduation Day tradition is to have breakfast together. At 9:00 am the Grade 8 students will come together to share a meal together. The school covers the cost so all students can take part.

After the Breakfast, we will move to the gym to set up their Personal Graduation displays and to rehearse for the big event

Graduation Decorating and Organizing Times

The students will be working on decorations for displays for Graduation during the morning of Monday June 25 (Grad day) until noon. It is essential for all students to be here in order to set up their own personal display to share with parents and friends during Grad. The students have been informed of the requirements in advance so they can bring in their personal display items early. This display is to be a collection or a collage that represents them. Items students brought in the past years include: Photos of family events, their Sacraments, pictures of birthday parties, and class trips, trophies and medals from teams and sports they have taken part in, Student of the Month awards certificates, projects they did well,

hobbies, art work, their favourite stuffed animal and even the outfit worn on the first day of Kindergarten.

All display items must be taken home the night of Graduation since the gym is being used the next morning.

We only have the gym on Monday morning to set up and rehearse for the night. Please ensure your child is here for these days. Book all hair appointments etc., for after the 1:00 pm lunch dismissal.

If your child will not be here in the afternoon due to appointments or special family gatherings, please contact the school so we do not need to intrude on your family time.

We look forward to our Graduation evening and seeing all the family members share in the successes of our Graduating Students.

ECHOBOWL TRIP: Wednesday, June 27
