Dear Parents,

This year, the students in Grade 3A, 3B and grade 3 students from grade 3/4 will be participating in the Lifesaving Society's 'Swim to Survive' program at the Wayne Gretzky Centre in Brantford. During this program, the students will be given a brief swim test to determine individual swimming abilities. Next, the students will be put into small groups to receive swimming instruction on how to roll, tread water and swim.

The dates for the Swim to Survive program are: Oct. 4, Oct. 11, and Oct. 18, 2017.

The students will be in the pool from 9:30-10:25.

We will be leaving the school at 9:00 and returning to school by 11:00.

Once we return from the pool, students will have a nutrition break to eat their lunch, then go outside for some fresh air for 20 minutes.

This program is FREE for all students. Students are asked to bring the following items:

- A bathing suit (please send your child to school with his/her bathing suit on underneath his/her clothes on our swim days (please pack underwear for later)
- A large towel
- A comb or brush
- A cloth bag to carry item in (include a plastic bag for wet bathing suit and towel)

It is recommended that you label your child's items that he/she will be bringing with them as we are often not the only group swimming at the Gretzky Centre.

The instructors run the program and ensure that your child is safe in the water at all times. Parents are welcome to watch their child participate in this program. There is on Observation Deck on the second level above the pool. Parents will not be riding the bus, but can meet us at the pool.
