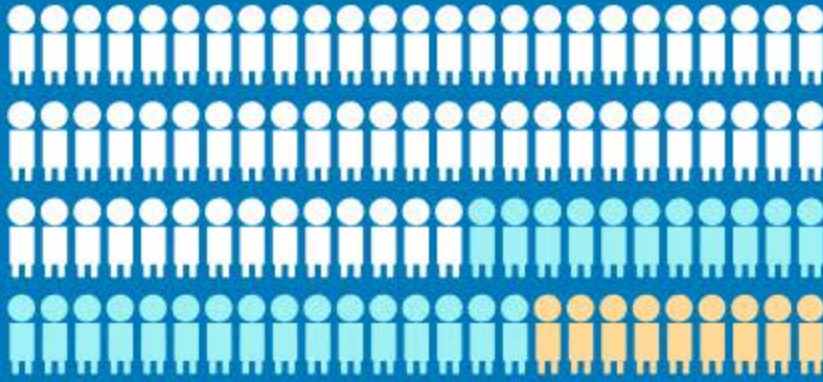




Eye See...Eye Learn® 2017-18 Program Highlights

of children who participated received their first-ever eye exam. That's 47%.

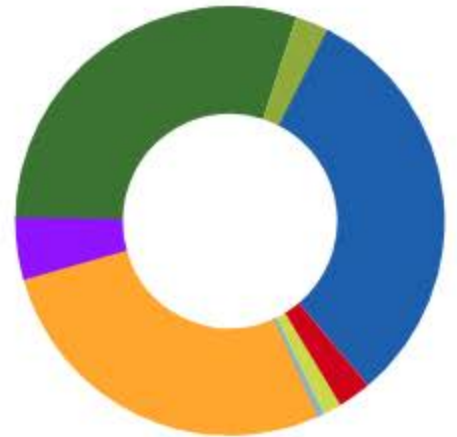
3,244

In 18,975 exams where no glasses were prescribed, the following eye health conditions were diagnosed:

- 4% myopia
- 48% astigmatism
- 7% amblyopia
- 1% other condition
- 46% hyperopia
- 4% strabismus
- 2% eye health abnormality
- 41% normal refractive error
